Tournament Rules and Reminders

Important Pre-Tournament Dates

- **Monday, June 15, 2026, at 6:00 PM** Golf Genius Training/Event Information Meeting for all golfers. A link will be sent out before the meeting.
- **Wednesday, June 17, 2026 (no later than)**
 - Please ask your sponsors to purchase their tickets
 - Please turn in all sold paper tickets and money - the fewer people turning in cash and tickets on the morning of the event, the better.
 - Please get in touch with any of the undersigned to make those arrangements.
- **Thursday, June 18, 2026, at 8:00 PM** is the deadline to purchase online raffle tickets.

Tournament Start and End Times

- Please arrive at the Amherst Country Club no later than 5:15 AM. After loading your carts, there will be a brief review of the tournament rules, so we need all golfers with bags on carts ready to roll by 5:30 AM.
- Carts will be released at 5:45 AM. There will be a shotgun start promptly at 6:00 AM.
- **All rounds must be completed, and all electronic scores must be submitted by 7:30 PM.**
 - **Scores posted after 7:30 PM will not be counted.**
- **Please do not play any extra holes once you have completed all rounds!**
- The Cocktail Hour begins at 6:45 PM – you will have two free drink coupons that will be supplied on the patio. The Closing Awards Ceremony and Banquet will begin at 7:45 PM.

ACC Course Rules

- Men play from the blue tees; women play from the gold tees.
- USGA rules apply, other than local course exceptions.
- We are playing preferred lies **only in your own fairway. There are no preferred lies in the rough or in other fairways.** You may place your ball no more than 6” from its original spot and no closer to the hole. Otherwise, your ball will be played as it lies.
- If your ball lies in a footprint or strike mark in a non-raked sand trap, you may place it within a scorecard width of its original spot.
- Ground under repair will be clearly marked with white paint; the relief is one club length, no closer to the hole.
- Golfers may invite a guest to drive the cart and/or to assist as a forecaddie.

- Golf Carts – use the sides of the fairways and avoid long runs down the fairway. Please obey all cart directional signs. Carts are to stay on cart paths near tee boxes and greens.
- The Amherst Country Club is an Audubon-certified bird and wildlife sanctuary. Many of the lateral hazard areas are protected. These areas are marked with red stakes with green tops. These areas are absolutely "NO ENTRY" areas. If your ball goes into one, don't go look for it. Play the shot as a lateral hazard.
- Around several tees and greens, there are areas of high grass. If your ball goes in one of these areas, you may take a cursory look for it, but these are "NO SEARCH" areas. Play it as a lost ball.

Inclement Weather

- The tournament will be played rain or shine unless we have extreme weather that poses a risk to golfers or the golf course.
- A lightning warning will be three blasts of the air horn.
- If play is stopped due to inclement weather, mark your ball so it can easily be identified and immediately head directly to the clubhouse.
 - Please pick up any volunteers you may see returning to the Clubhouse.

Scoring

- The first five holes are practice and do not count towards your final score, although they may be used at the discretion of the 100 Holes Committee if the tournament ends early due to inclement weather.
- Official scoring will be done through the Golf Genius App. If you haven't already, please download it before the tournament starts.
- You must post your score on Golf Genius after every hole.
- **If you do not record your scores in the Golf Genius app, your scores will not be counted.**
- Paper scorecards are provided for golfers to keep track of their own scores and to serve as a backup/verification of electronic entry in case of technical issues.
- The paper scorecards will be marked for your first practice and live starting holes.
- Scoring will be based on the 90 holes played continuously after your five practice holes.
- A representative from the Amherst County Club will be available all day at the 1st tee to answer any questions about Golf Genius.
- If inclement weather prevents completion of the 90 scoring holes, the Tournament Committee may, at their discretion, make adjustments so that final scores are based on everyone playing the same number of holes.

Pace of Play

- Based on the 13.5 hours allotted for play, nine holes must be completed in 1 hour and 20 minutes, and 18 holes within 2 hours and 40 minutes (including the closest-to-the-pin contest hole between holes 16 and 17). By keeping up with this pace and the group in front of you, you will be able to maintain an appropriate pace of play.
- Tournament officials will be monitoring pace of play – if you are not keeping up with the group in front of you, you will be asked to speed up. If you are too far behind, you may be asked to pick up your ball, mark down double-bogey on the hole and move on to the next hole. Your cooperation in this regard is greatly appreciated!

- Always play “ready golf” – do not spend time helping your playing partner look for lost balls.
- Play is restricted to Twosomes and Threesomes. Foursomes and fivesomes are strongly discouraged.
- If groups do combine and the pace of play is affected, we respectfully reserve the right to split you back into your original groupings.
- **Your maximum score is *double-bogey*** – if you are one over par on a hole and are not yet in the hole, please immediately pick up your ball and mark down your score as a double-bogey – do not continue playing.
- There will be an “Inside the Leather” gimmie on each green. To measure:
 - Place the putter club head (standard length 33-36” putter only, no belly clubs) inside the cup edge nearest your ball.
 - Lay the putter flat on the putting surface, extending towards the ball.
 - If the ball is between the cup and the bottom of the grip (i.e., if the ball lies next to the shaft part of the putter), the next putt is a gimme. Add one stroke to your score and pick up your ball.
 - Your playing partner(s) must agree that a putt is a gimme.
- Please do not look for a ball hit into any sanctuary area – play your ball as if you lost it in a lateral hazard

Prizes

Skins Pool

- All golfers will automatically be entered into our Skins Pool at no cost. All skins winners will be awarded a Gift Certificate for a Foursome with two carts at Amherst Country Club.

Handicap Flights

- There are THREE handicap flights. Your GHIN handicap index will determine which flight you will compete in.
- A “Callaway” flight will contain those golfers who do not have a GHIN handicap.
- For each of the three handicap divisions, the low-gross and low-net winners will be awarded \$250 in Pro Shop credit and \$250 in cash.
- The Callaway low gross winner will also win \$250 in Pro Shop credits and \$250 cash.
- The golfer from any handicap division with an overall low net will receive the Ted Jordan Trophy award.
- The lowest gross score wins the use of the coveted Madras Jacket for one year.

19th Hole (Closest to Pin Contest Hole) – New format this year!

- The 19th contest hole is played after you finish Hole 16 and before proceeding to the 17th tee
- A new change for 2026: there will be one winner for closest to the pin *for each round*.
- The Contest Hole will be skipped while you are playing your 5 practice holes.
- Each winner will be awarded a single round with cart at Amherst Country Club.
- To maintain pace of play, balls will be provided on this hole – you will not need to retrieve your ball
- Please maintain course etiquette as the 16th green and 17th tee are nearby.

Par 3 Closest to the Pin Contests – New this year!

- All par 3 holes (#'s 3, 7, 13, 15) will have a Closest to The Pin contest.
- *Practice holes are NOT included.*
- There will be one closest to the pin winner per Par 3 hole for the tournament. Each winner will receive a \$100 Amherst Country Club Pro Shop Credit.
